<p><b>CAFOD</b> (St Helen's)      <i>pray-fast-give</i> Some years ago, a colleague was seconded from teaching for a short time to work on education projects with Unilever. The company was going through a product reorganisation. Some chemical processes were being moved wholesale to developing countries. When asked why, he was told that it was cheaper to do this than to meet environmental standards in the UK. It remains the case that such standards are lower and, where they are not, they are poorly enforced, in many developing countries. Mariluz lives close to a coal mine in Colombia owned by a UK listed company. She says <i>"I want to make visible the problem in our community ... health. Children suffer from skin problems, bronchitis, pneumonia and diarrhoea because of pollution. (Some) ... communities suffer being uprooted and have to leave (their local area.)"</i> CAFOD offers legal support for such communities to challenge the companies concerned.</p>	<p><b>UNITY WEEK:</b> The Week of Prayer for Christian Unity begins on 18th January.
